



DISTINGUISHED VISITING PROFESSOR IN THE LIBERAL ARTS LECTURE BY HEID ERDRICH

Distinguished Visiting Professor in the Liberal Arts Heid E. Erdrich will give a public lecture on her poetry. Erdrich is Ojibwe enrolled at Turtle Mountain, interdisciplinary artist, and author of eight books of poetry and prose. Her poemeos (poem films and videos) created in collaboration with Elizabeth Day, Jonathan Thunder, and Trevino Brings Plenty, have won Best of Show and Best of Fest awards. Erdrich has curated dozens of art exhibits focused on Native American artists. In 2016 she was a contributing artist to the Creative City Challenge award-winning public art project *Wolf and Moose* by Christopher Lutter-Gardella. Erdrich has collaborated with Rosy Simas Danse since 2016, and she has contributed to works choreographed by Ananya Dance, Zorongo Flamenco Dance Theater, and others. Erdrich has written plays produced by Pangea World Theater. She performs her poetry across the country, sometimes collaborating with musicians, visual artists, and dancers. Her first exhibit as a featured artist is *Skew Lines, May 2019*, created in a dual residency with Rosy Simas for SooVac gallery in Minneapolis.
