

September's Community Meal will highlight traditional Native American foods and locally grown produce on Monday, September 19, from 5:30–7 p.m. at Faith Lutheran Church (108 West 8th Street, Morris, MN 56267). Anishinaabe language instructor Gabe Desrosiers will share words of gratitude for the harvest and meal at 5:15 p.m. The meal will consist of Niswi Ikwewag miijim- (Three Sisters Casserole, vegan or with Maskode Bizhiki wiiyaas-buffalo meat), Minoomin wenjimaagak gaa-zaagaskwaajimikaag (wild rice from Leech lake), Gaa-oondeg nibiishaan (marinated fresh vegetable salad), Bakweshigan (bannock, a traditional bread), and Asasaweniminaaboo (chokecherry sauce). Food for the meal comes from the on-campus Native American gardens, Organic Gardening Club, Morris Area Farmers Market, Sisseton Wahpeton Oyate Youth Department, Minnesota Chippewa Tribe's SNAP Education, Prairie Horizons Farm, West Central Research and Outreach Center, Willie's SuperValu, and Pomme de Terre Foods.
