STEVENS County CARES Grant Program Grant Applications For Businesses & Non-Profit Organizations Impacted by COVID 19

Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis until September 1, 2020 at 4 p.m.

Stevens County CARES Grant Program is now open to businesses and nonprofits with a physical location in Stevens County who have experienced reduced revenue and/or increased demand for services in response to COVID-19.

Businesses and nonprofits may request up to \$10,000 and must apply by September 1, 2020. Actual grant funds awarded will be based on a number of key factors as outlined in the application forms.

Due to the short timeframe, I encourage all applicants to apply as soon as they are ready. Stevens County wants to help as many of our businesses and nonprofits as possible.

Women's Voices in Stevens County: A Suffrage Centennial

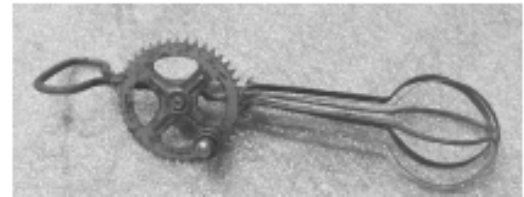
Now-December 30, 2020
